ABOUT THE CLINIC

In partnership with Legal Services Alabama and its John Lewis Legal Services Fellowship Program, attorneys in Bradley's Birmingham office provide pro bono legal consultation services to Black business owners and nonprofit leaders in the Birmingham area through a monthly legal advice clinic. The clinic is the second in Bradley's footprint dedicated to addressing the effects of systemic racism and racial discrimination facing the Black community and Black-owned businesses and nonprofit organizations in particular. The first clinic was launched in Nashville in January 2021.

AVAILABLE SERVICES

Participants will have access to attorneys who will offer a range of free, businessoriented consultations, including:

- Business Formation
- Corporate Governance
- Local and State Regulations
- Contract Review
- State and Federal Taxes

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The clinics are held monthly and are aimed at businesses and nonprofit organizations with:

- Majority ownership and control by Black owners and leaders
- 10 or fewer employees
- New or established small business or nonprofit
- Located in the Birmingham area

CLINIC DATES AND LOCATIONS

The April clinic will take place on Friday, April 29 at noon CST. All other clinics will be held on the fourth Thursday of each month at noon CST. The clinics are currently being held by video conference or phone.
